Rayma Neeb Women's Re-Entry Scholarship

1. DEADLINE for scholarship applications is Wednesday, March 20, 2019. (No exceptions.)
2. Refer to criteria below for eligibility requirements.
3. Refer to application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e. reference letters, evidence of enrollment, etc.) Incomplete applications will be disqualified.
4. If any question does not apply to you in this application please put N/A in the space. Do not leave the space blank.
5. Type or print legibly. Illegible applications will be returned to you. You may also download a copy of the application online: www.evzonta.org.

Purpose: To provide a \$2,000 scholarship to a woman who has entered or re-entered college after at least a 4 year hiatus to enable herself to be self-sufficient. The course of study must qualify her for a higher position/profession than she currently has.

Criteria:

1. Be a U.S. Citizen or legal resident of the U.S. and a resident of Arizona.
2. Be enrolled (or accepted) in an accredited college, university or trade school in a degree or diploma program.
3. Demonstrate financial need.
4. Have an enrollment status equal to at least a half-time student.
5. Have/maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale. This requirement shall be waived for the first term of re-entry.

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly.)
2. A letter of application to the Zonta Foundation of the East Valley, describing your goals and how the scholarship will advance those goals.
3. Two (2) recent character references in the form of a letter of recommendation.
4. A recent transcript with cumulative grade point average (if a continuing student.)

DEADLINE for the application is Wednesday, March 20, 2019. Applications postmarked or received via email after this date will not be considered. No incomplete applications will be considered.

Interview: If you qualify for a personal interview you will be contacted.

Announcement of Scholarship Recipient(s): May 2019

Special Provision: Scholarship funds will be issued directly to the recipient's school and may not be used to pay back college loans of any kind.
