The American Legion Auxiliary, Department of Arizona, offers scholarships in the field of Health Care Occupations and Nurses Training.

NURSES SCHOLARSHIP:

These scholarships are awarded annually to not less than a second year student who is enrolled in an accredited institution in Arizona awaiting a degree as a Registered Nurse. Applicant must be a citizen of the United States and a resident of Arizona for at least one year. Rules and regulations are on the back of the application. An Application is enclosed but you may make as many copies as you need.

HEALTH CARE OCCUPATIONS SCHOLARSHIP:

Applicants must be enrolled or enrolling in an accredited tax-supported institution in Arizona which offers a certificate or degree program in Health Care Occupations (i.e. Nurses Assistance, Dental Assistant, LPN, Lab Technician, Physical Therapist, Inhalation Therapist, etc.). Applicant must be a citizen of the United States and a resident of Arizona for at least one year. Rules and regulations are on the back of the application. An application is enclosed but you may make as many copies as you need.

It would be greatly appreciated if these applications be made available to anyone interested in continuing their education in Nursing or any Health Care Occupations.

HEALTH CARE OCCUPATIONS

The American Legion Auxiliary Department of Arizona will accept applications for assistance to students pursuing a career in Health Care Occupations. The applicant must be enrolled or enrolling in an accredited, tax-supported institution in Arizona which offers a certificate or degree program in Health Care Occupations. (i.e. Nurses Assistant, Dental Assistant, L.P.N., Lab Technician, Physical Therapist, Inhalation therapist; etc.) Applicant must be a U.S. Citizen and a resident of Arizona for at least one year. The immediate family member of a Veteran will be given first consideration. The amount of the scholarship is \$500.00.

Applications must be received by May 15th preceding the term to be commenced in the fall with final selection being made by the Past President' Parley Chairman and three (3) Past Department Presidents. Any scholarship assistance awarded to the applicant will be forwarded to the school accepting the student for courses in Health Care Occupations at the beginning of the Fall Term.

Selection for assistance will be made on the following basis:

Character	25%	Scholarship	25%
Financial Need	30%	Initiative	20%

Submit application with attachments in the following order:

1. Completed application.
2. Photograph of self.
3. Statement, in narrative form, not to exceed 500 words, giving family, school, church activities and reasons for choosing a career in Health Care Occupations.
4. Three (3) letters of reference from persons who can testify to character, study and work habits i.e. High School Principal, Instructors, Counselor, Clergyman, Employer.)
5. Transcripts of previous year's grades and test scores.

PAST PRESIDENTS' PARLEY NURSES SCHOLARSHIPS
(MUST BE AT LEAST A SECOND YEAR STUDENT)

The amount of the scholarship is to be \$600.00 annually to not less than a second year student nurse who is enrolled in an accredited institution In Arizona awarding a degree as a Registered Nurse. The immediate family members of a Veteran will be given first preference. Applicant must be a citizen of the United States and resident of Arizona for at least one (1) year.

Applications for this scholarship must be sent to the American Legion Auxiliary Department of Arizona Past Presidents' Parley Chairman by May 15th preceding the term to be commenced in the fall. Money awarded will be paid at the beginning of the school year to the institution where applicant is enrolled in the nursing program.

Final selection will be made by the American Legion Auxiliary through the Past Presidents' Parley Chairman and committee of three (3) Past Department Presidents.

Applicant must be enrolled in second year or advance nursing program as an upper division student and carry the required hours of work with a grade average of "C" or better.

Selection for assistance will be made on the following basis:

Character	25%	Scholarship	25%
Financial Need	30%	Initiative	20%

Submit application with attachments in the following order:

1. Completed application.
2. Photograph of self.
3. Statement, in narrative form, not to exceed 500 words, giving family background, civic, social, school, church activities including reason applicant feels qualified for the scholarship and why a nursing career is pursued.
4. Three (3) letters of reference from persons who can testify to character, study and work habits i.e. Instructors, Scholarship/Financial Aid Director, Standards Committee, Counselor, Clergyman, Employer.)
5. A transcript of previous year's nursing grades.

Former recipients continuing degree program in nursing (R.N., B.A., and M.A.) shall be given first consideration provided applicant complies with above rules.
