- **Certification of Naturalization**

If your status is an **eligible Non-Citizen**, please provide your most current unexpired immigrant documentation, such as:

- **I-94 Form**
- **Permanent Resident Card I-551, or**
- **I-797, Notice of Action from USCIS with "Notice Type: Approval Notice"**
